**NOTICE TO CANDIDATES FOR VIEWING THEIR MARKS IN THE COMPUTER BASED  
EXAMINATION FOR THE POST OF UDC IN ESIC**

Vide this office Notice dated 20.02.2017 link was provided to all the candidates for the post of UDC to view their Score in the Computer Based Examination held in the month of March, 2017 in 8 shifts.

Also vide Notice dated 29.4.2016, a link was also provided to all candidates for viewing the (1) Questions (2) Correct Answers and (3) Answers Marked by the Candidate in the Online Examination for the post of UDC and submitting Objections (if any) by 6.5.2016 was uploaded on ESIC Website. Thereafter, vide Notice Dated: 20.06.2016, the Question Paper along with Final Answer Keys were uploaded on ESIC website.

Candidates were also advised to verify their particulars and discrepancy, if any, may be intimated to the concerned office of ESIC for which the candidate had applied by 28<sup>th</sup> February, 2017.

Apart from requests received from candidates for corrections in their personal details/particulars, following queries are also received from some candidates:

<b>Sl. No.</b>	<b>Queries</b>	<b>Reply</b>
01.	Where discrepancy in their scores is reported by some candidates it is found that in most of the cases these candidates have <b>Marked their Answers for Review</b> which are not considered for evaluation purpose.	In the instructions given on Admit Card it was clearly mentioned that <b>"The Marked for Review Status for a question simply indicates that you would like to look at that question again. If a question is answered and Marked for Review, your answer for that question will not be considered in the evaluation."</b>  <b>To Save his/her Answer the candidates were instructed that they MUST click on SAVE and NEXT button.</b>
02.	Where candidates have requested for <b>giving Bonus Marks against Invalid Questions</b>	The score of the candidates for selection is considered only against the Valid Questions. The scores of candidates are scaled to a Common Scale of 200 for the purpose of generating Combined Merit List.
03.	Where candidates have complaint regarding <b>no instructions was given for Negative Marking.</b>	Negative Marking of 0.25 marks for each wrong answer was notified in the advertisement as well mentioned in the Admit Card.
